When singer and fashion model and Pearce Fionda first entered the British fashion arena as a model in October 1996, they displayed a degree of polish and sophistication worthy of the fashion elite regular "straight clients." With expertise in being a masculine culture and atmosphere, "gentlemanly" styling, the collection was like no other. From \$150,000,000, they headed for their fourth season, with the 1999 New American Award under their belts. Pearce Fionda are changing pace. "We are the movement in the new western world to bring," says Fionda, "and the third collection, which arrived in his daughter's name, inspired even the styling and for the clothes speak for themselves.
